Kenya:

Hope this mail finds you well. One of my church members by the name Susan, is a primary school teacher, whose teaching colleague has had marital problems for sometime. She even contemplated divorce. She shared her frustrations with Susan. Not knowing what more to do, she decided

Mexico:

For each container sent into Guatemala, part of the material is distributed and used in southern Mexico. This material is first sent to western Guatemala where it is prepared by Guatemalan workers for delivery into Mexico. Delivery into southern Mexico is very dangerous due to the persecution. Next is a short note from one of the Guatemala

workers. "We continue to support the Chiapas, Mexico communities with Bible resources even though there is persecution of Pastors, and the Christian communities. Please continue praying for Chiapas. We send the Bible literature into Mexico using back roads and vehicles with Mexican license plates. The Pastors come to pick up the materials and after that I make trips to meet the leaders and encourage them in using and distributing the resources. The Christian community is really growing. We are also working with other ministries and a Bible Institute to distribute the literature. We pray for plans to send more."

Nigeria:

Some good news, we have 27 Moslems from a town called Kubwa, 56 from a town called Jaba, 83 from a town called Mabushi, 14 from a town called Wuse all these towns are in Moslem strong holds. These all have denied Allah of Quran and embraced salvation. They have all accepted that Allah is Satan and accepted that Jesus as Lord Almighty. Steve there are also a lot of healings. God is opening many more doors for us.

Early last year, Lawrence was introduced to me by a friend. Lawrence is a widower who has two teenage daughters. The wife died when the last born was barely one year. He hasn't married ever since. All throughout his life has been a mess. He has been a heavy drinker of alcohol. He has also been rescued three times from attempting suicide. Once he has been beaten by mob for suspicion that he stole. So when he was brought to me, I gave him menial jobs whenever we cleared the container, by offloading, maintaining the cleanliness of the store and sometimes taking loads to the bus station. He would also take a few magazines to read. On my part, I would invite him to church which he never came the whole of last year. I never gave up, I just kept giving him
